

## **ORDINANCE AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 22, 2007:**

ORD. NO. 5-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of 1.616 acres of street right-of-way along Weathervane Lane to M & M Royalty, Ltd., for the "Cedarwood Unit No. 1D" gas/oil well unitization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 6-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of the Leggett Community Learning Center on property at 619 Sumner Street; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 7-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by MK-MK, Inc., (also known as MKMK, Inc.), located at 301 N. Howard Street for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight, facilitating the development of new housing, and furthering the objectives of the Elizabeth Park Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 8-2007 accepting the resignation of Councilman Daniel M. Horrigan from the office of Councilman for Ward 1 of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 9-2007 establishing February 12, 2007 as the date of the election by Council to fill the Ward 1 vacancy created by the resignation of Daniel M. Horrigan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 10-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest, temporary right-of-way easement, utility easement and work agreement interest in certain real property owned by William R. Hunt III and Brenda Hunt located at 601 and 613 E. Tallmadge Avenue, for the purposes of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 11-2007 declaring it necessary to improve West Market Street between the termini of Pershing Avenue and Hawkins Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 12-2007 declaring it necessary to improve Howard Street between Lods Street and Cuyahoga Falls Avenue by paving, grading, constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewer house laterals, sanitary sewers, storm sewers and water mains, installing roof drain pipes, installing street lighting, installing traffic signalization and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 13-2007 determining to proceed with the improvement of Kenmore Boulevard between certain termini by paving, grading, constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete and brick sidewalks and driveway approaches, installing roof drain pipes, installing street lighting, installing traffic signalization, installing water mains, and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 14-2007 levying special assessments for the improvement of Roslyn Avenue between certain termini by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes and street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 15-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to amend its Agreement of Cooperation with the County of Summit for the design and construction of a water main on South Main Street and Killian Road for the Summit County Roadway Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 16-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with a consultant for the design of the Towpath Trail behind AES to Bartges Street adjacent to the canal; authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an LPA agreement with ODOT for the design and construction of the AES Bartges Towpath Trail; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 17-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Cascade Locks Bikeway Phase IIA; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 18-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of a bridge on Abington Road over the Springfield Lake Outlet; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 19-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to solicit proposals and to advertise for bids and to enter into contracts for the maintenance of various parks, traffic islands and miscellaneous City properties for 2007; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 20-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with engineering firms for miscellaneous engineering services required by the Utilities Services Division; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 21-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Siemens, without the formality of advertising for bids, to purchase equipment to expand the City's existing access control system to include the new security fence at Johnston Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 22-2007 ratifying the actions of the Purchasing Agent in entering into a contract with American Fleet Services for the emergency repair of Ladder 4, an Akron Fire Department emergency response vehicle; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 23-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by John A. Bean and Mabel Bean, and being a vacant lot located at 419 Hickory Street, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight, facilitating the development of new housing, and furthering the objectives of the Hickory Corridor Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 24-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the Helen Arnold Community Learning Center/Akron Urban League project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 25-2007 accepting a vacation plat for two unnamed alleys west of Rhodes Avenue and south of Vernon Odom Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.
