

## **ORDINANCE AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 12, 2007:**

RES. NO. 60-2007 appointing James P. Hurley III to fill the vacancy in the Akron City Council Ward 1 position for the term ending December 31, 2007; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 61-2007 adopting the 2007 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, also known as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 62-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish Permatex, Inc., on property at 1559 South Main Street; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 63-2007 expressing support for the application of East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation for Low Income Housing Tax Credits for the Washington Homes Development; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 64-2007 declaring it necessary to improve Pelton Avenue between the termini of Celtic Street and Allenford Street, Celtic Street between the termini of Manchester Road and Edwin Avenue, and Westmoreland Street between the termini of Manchester Road and Nesmith Lake Boulevard by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 65-2007 declaring it necessary to improve Hampton Knoll Drive between the termini of Akron-Peninsula Road and the cul-de-sac by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, driveway approaches and storm sewers; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 66-2007 declaring it necessary to lay out, establish, construct, maintain and in the City off-street parking facilities for motor vehicles, on Spicer Street between East Exchange Street and Crouse Street, by acquiring real property or interests therein and constructing and improving such parking facilities; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 67-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Ken Zwolinski for the sale and removal of a vacant rental house on Watershed property that is no longer needed by the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 68-2007 authorizing the Mayor to file an application for a grant and enter into an agreement for funding from the 2006 Buffer Zone Protection Program to purchase additional security equipment for a critical infrastructure site; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 69-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the LEGGETT COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 70-2007 approving the sale of vacant City-owned land located along North Howard Street and Flower Court to the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority in conjunction with their Hope VI application; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
