

ORDINANCE AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 26, 2007

ORD. NO. 72-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261-11.57/Tallmadge Avenue project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 73-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with a consultant for the design of improvements to the roofing system at the Incubator-Accelerator building; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 74-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an Airport Access Agreement with LMA Commerce, Ltd., for the operation of a fixed base operation at the Akron Fulton International Airport; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 75-2007 congratulating James E. Payne on the occasion of his retirement from service as Deputy Director of Law and thanking him for his 23 years of dedicated service.

RES. NO. 76-2007 congratulating Fire Chief Charles Gladman on the occasion of his retirement and thanking him for his 34 years of dedicated service; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 77-2007 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement or agreements with local agencies to carry out the Emergency Shelter Grant Program for program year 2007; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 78-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of a recycling center on property at 633 East Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 79-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with a consultant for the design and construction management of a parking deck east of Dart Avenue and north of the Superblock Parking Deck; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 80-2007 approving and confirming the appointment of Tracy Carter Johnson and the reappointments of Dr. George E. Goldman, Laraine Duncan, and Richard Neal to the Akron Health Commission; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 81-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay the sum of \$5,000 to the Shaw JCC of Akron for sponsorship of KidsFair 2006; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 82-2007 approving the donation of City owned land to the State of Ohio for the SUM 93-6.92 / MANCHESTER ROAD project; determining said property is not needed for public use and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 83-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts with Dawson Insurance, Inc. for the purchase of lead hazard reduction liability insurance for the City of Akron housing rehabilitation program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 84-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Ampco System Parking for the management and operation of City-owned parking facilities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 85-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of repairs to various sidewalks throughout the City; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 86-2007 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the tools, labor and material to rebuild one Wastewater Treatment Plant Influent Parkson screen and install one rebuilt Headworks screen at the Water Pollution Control Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 87-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a mutual aid agreement with surrounding communities regarding accident reconstruction activities; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 88-2007 Ordinance accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the LEGGETT COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 89-2007 approving and authorizing the execution of a Development and Ground Lease Agreement with Universal Tire Molds, Inc. (“Redeveloper”), providing for the lease of property with the option to purchase for redevelopment pursuant to the Massillon Road Industrial Park Redevelopment Plan (“Plan”); finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 90-2007 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Massillon Road Industrial Park Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes, establishing the Massillon Road Industrial Park Redevelopment Tax Increment Equivalent Fund (Universal Tire Molds, Inc.), all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency.
