

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 9, 2007

ORD. NO. 166-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$15,000 for an operating subsidy to Cascade Locks Park Association; declaring this expenditure of funds to be in the public interest and for a public purpose; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 167-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay to East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation (EANDC) the sum of \$3,600.00 to assist the elderly with emergency home repairs in the year 2007; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 168-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Aon Risk Services, Inc. of Ohio for Professional Medical Liability Insurance for the Department of Health physicians; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 169-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron/Summit Convention & Visitors Bureau for the operation of the convention bureau in 2007; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 170-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$60,000 as an operating subsidy for the 2007 All-American Soap Box Derby; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 171-2007 accepting Temporary Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the KENMORE TOWPATH TRAIL project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 172-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the KENMORE TOWPATH TRAIL project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 173-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261 – 11.57 / TALLMADGE AVENUE project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 174-2007 approving the sale of City owned land located at 953 Greenwood Avenue to Mustard Seed Development Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 175-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or installation of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, riser rings and Hot Inplace Recycling (HIR) for various streets in the 2007 Micro Paving Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 176-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of improvements to West Market Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 177-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of a cul-de-sac on Avon Street; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 178-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of two snow and ice trucks used in the Street Cleaning Division; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 179-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of a day care business center at 515 Ardella Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 180-2007 amending The Zoning Map by changing the UPD-1 Use District Classification along east and west sides of Brittain Road, between East Tallmadge Avenue and Independence Avenue to a Retail Business Use District (U3, H1, A2) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 181-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of an office development at 341 White Pond Drive; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 182-2007 authorizing the expenditure of funds for the purchase of savings bonds, food, and other items for the City of Akron Holocaust Commemoration on April 17, 2007; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 183-2007 establishing a budgeted strength of 512 full-time police officers in the Akron Police Division, conditioned upon voter approval of Issue 17 on the May 8, 2007 ballot; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 184-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest, a temporary right-of-way easement, and work agreement interest in certain real property owned by Alice Williams, located at 462 E. Tallmadge Ave., for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57/Tallmadge Avenue Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 185-2007 determining to proceed with the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 186-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of the new Mill Street Bridge from Broadway to College; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 187-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of improvements to the landscaping along I-77 from Copley Road to State Route 21; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 188-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into an agreement for Violence Against Women Act grant funds administered by the office of Criminal Justice Services; authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 189-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials to refurbish Fire and EMS vehicles; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.
