

## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 23, 2007**

ORD. NO. 205-2007 approving the sale of City owned land to Lance & Monica Weimer; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 206-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the LEGGETT COMMUNITY CENTER project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 207-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron for economic development purposes; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 208-2007 determining to proceed to lay out, establish, construct, maintain and operate in the City off-street parking facilities for motor vehicles, on Spicer Street between East Exchange Street and Crouse Street, by acquiring real property or interests therein and constructing and improving such parking facilities; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 209-2007 Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 546-2006, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of a deck on property at 905 Alder Run Way, by amending Condition (1) regarding the distance of the deck from the rear (east) property line; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 210-2007 accepting a vacation and rededication plat for the vacation and rededication of a portion of North Maple Street, Hickory Street, and North Walnut Street; accepting the dedication plat for land along Hickory Street and North Walnut; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 211-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest, temporary right of way interest, a temporary work agreement easement, and a permanent utility easement in certain real property owned by Richard D. Leslie and Delores M. Leslie, located at 573 East Tallmadge Avenue, for the purposes of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in connection with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 212-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Pearl Matthews, located at 243 Lods Street, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight, facilitating the development of new housing and furthering the objectives of the Elizabeth Park Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 213-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation to construct the Waterloo Road Towpath Trail; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 214-2007 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain property in the City by installing roadway improvements for Park West Boulevard between certain termini, together with the necessary appurtenance thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 215-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and material to construct new and replacement 6, 8, 12 and 16 inch water mains in various locations to serve City of Akron water customers; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 216-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into an agreement for the FY 2007 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant administered by the United States Bureau of Justice Assistance; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 217-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for funds and enter into a grant agreement from the "2007 Project Safe Neighborhoods" grant administered through the U.S. Department of Justice, U.S. Attorney's Office; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 218-2007 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement with Akron Edgewood Development Corporation to provide for the construction of residential units in the new mixed income Edgewood Homes Hope VI Area; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 219-2007 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the White Pond Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes, providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District, establishing the White Pond Urban Redevelopment Area Redevelopment Tax Increment Equivalent Fund, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency.
