

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 7, 2007

ORD. NO. 235-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the renovation of the storage buildings on Evans Avenue and at the Municipal Service Center; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 236-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the University of Akron providing for the loan of twenty city-owned Draeger self-contained breathing apparatus units to the University to train students; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 237-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the KENMORE TOWPATH TRAIL project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 238-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the VICTORIA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AREA project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 239-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the development requirements to eliminate the 5 feet landscaped parking setback for a used car lot at 33 West Waterloo Road.

ORD. NO. 240-2007 rejecting the report and recommendations of the Fact Finder in the matter of City of Akron and Akron Firefighters Association IAFF, Local 330, Case No. 06-MED-10-1187; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 241-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the maintenance of expressway lighting on the portions of I-76, I-277, S.R.8, S.R. 59 and S.R. 224 in the City; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 242-2007 determining to proceed with the improvement of Hartford Avenue between the termini of Copley Road and Lawton Street, and Nome Avenue between the termini of Courtland Avenue and Tacker Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, driveway approaches, concrete sidewalks and brick pavement; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 243-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials for the inspection, repair, and painting of the Firestone Standpipe Water Tank; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.
