

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 18, 2007

ORD. NO. 315-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 316-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261 – 11.57 / TALLMADGE AVENUE project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 317-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Telecom Remarketing Corporation of America for the sale of surplus Nortel equipment; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 318-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the waterproofing of Building #2 at the Municipal Service Center; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 319-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the replacement and rehabilitation of the tot lot at the Summit Lake Community Center; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 320-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and installation of play equipment at Forest Lodge Park and construction of improvements to the play area; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 321-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the City of Cuyahoga Falls to provide surplus water service to portions of Cuyahoga Falls; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 322-2007 authorizing a change in the boundary line separating the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 323-2007 Resolution declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Matthew Westfall and Teri Westfall, located at 595 and 597 Sumner Street, for the purposes of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 324-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Donna C. Jones, located at 317 Cross Street, for the purposes of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 325-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Matthew Westfall and Teri Westfall, located at 565-567 Sumner Street, for the purposes of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 326-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Matthew Westfall and Teri Westfall, located at 572 Allyn Street, for the purposes of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 327-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest, temporary right of way easement, a temporary work agreement easement, and a permanent utility easement in certain real property owned by Dies Family Holdings, LLC, located at 643 East Tallmadge Avenue, for the purposes of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in connection with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 328-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest, a temporary right-of-way easement, temporary work agreement easement, and a permanent utility easement in certain real property owned by Richard D. Leslie and Delores M. Leslie, located at 573 E. Tallmadge Ave., for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 329-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and a temporary right-of-way easement in certain real property owned by Narrotam K. Patel and Shushils N. Patel, located at the S.E. corner of E. Tallmadge Avenue and Gorge Boulevard, for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57/Tallmadge Avenue Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 330-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest, a temporary right-of-way easement, a temporary work agreement easement, and a permanent utility easement in certain real property owned by Angelo Simone and JSCG Properties, LLC, located at 600-612 E. Tallmadge Ave., for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 331-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest, a temporary right-of-way easement, and a temporary work agreement easement, in certain real property owned by Angelo Simone and JSCG Properties, LLC, located at 590 E. Tallmadge Ave., for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 332-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Robert Wade, Jr., located at 312 Dean Street, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight, facilitating the development of new housing and furthering the objectives of the Elizabeth Park Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 333-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Evon Friend, being a vacant lot located at 203 East Lods Street, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight, facilitating the development of new housing and furthering the objectives of the Elizabeth Park Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 334-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into a grant agreement for Edward Byrne Memorial Discretionary Grant Funding to create a countrywide Gang Task Force Initiative; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 335-2007 authorizing the Mayor to file an application for a grant and enter into an agreement for funding from the FY 2007 Justice Assistance Grant administered through the Office of Criminal Justice Services to support a concentrated effort to eliminate the presence of gang activity in the City of Akron; authorizing the expenditure of local funds in support of this grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 336-2007 authorizing the Mayor to file an application for a grant and enter into an agreement for funding from the FY 2007 COPS Methamphetamine Initiative Grant administered through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, to support community policing efforts in preventing the production, use, and distribution of methamphetamine; and declaring an emergency.
