

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 2, 2007

ORD. NO. 343-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 344-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to grant an easement and right-of-way to Bruce A. and Janet P. Caudill, Kent Lincoln-Mercury, and Ford Leasing and Development Company, as their interests may appear, to maintain a paved parking area on, over, and through the City's force main right-of-way located on property in the City of Kent, County of Portage; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 345-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the labor, equipment, and materials to repair and resurface the roadway pavement at the Water Pollution Control Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 346-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261 – 11.57 / TALLMADGE AVENUE project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 347-2007 levying special assessments for the improvement of Bishop Street between certain termini by constructing and reconstructing curbs, sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; resurfacing; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 348-2007 levying special assessments for the improvement of Baird Street between certain termini by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, sidewalks, and driveway approaches; constructing storm sewers and storm sewers laterals; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 349-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of improvements to the pedestrian and bike trail system at Stan Hywet; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 350-2007 Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to file an application for a grant and enter into an agreement for funding from the FY 2007 COPS Technology Initiative Grant administered through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, to create a partnership with county government to establish a regional data sharing network; and declaring an emergency.
