

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 16, 2007

ORD. NO. 364-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 365-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the NEIGHBORHOOD HOUSING PETITION project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 366-2007 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into a contract with East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation (EANDC) for the Lead Elimination Action Program (LEAP) rehabilitation of 30 residential rental units in the City of Akron; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 367-2007 authorizing the Director of Health to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Health for Public Health Infrastructure funding for local health departments for local and regional infectious disease response, bio-terrorism preparedness and other public health emergencies; authorizing the Director of Health to enter into contracts with the Barberton Health Department, the Summit County Health Department, Glen Moore, and other entities to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 368-2007 approving the historic designation of 52-58 E. Mill Street and 128 S. High Street as an historic landmark; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 369-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a garage at 52 Mull Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 370-2007 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 289-2202, passed June 10, 2002, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a cluster home development on property at the southwest corner of the intersection of Smith Road and Sand Run Road by adding Condition (22) regarding open decks in the rear yard area; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 371-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with Akron Edgewood Development Corporation to provide for public street improvements in the Edgewood Homes Hope VI Area; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 372-2007 approving the Eastgate Urban Renewal Area Eligibility Report and Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 373-2007 amending and/or supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153 "Zoning Code" by enacting Section 153.530 "UPD-11" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron, to establish the Class UPD-11 District; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 374-2007 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Commercial Use District (U4, H1, A1) Classification for the area east of Kelly Avenue and east of Baltimore Avenue, south of Ninth Avenue, south of Tech Way Drive north of the properties fronting on the north side of Joy Avenue, north of the Baltimore Avenue extension, and west of the railroad property to an Ordinary Industry District (U5, H1, A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 375-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a bank at 656 West Market Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 376-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a parking lot at 2285 East Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 377-2007 providing for adjustments in employee compensation and compensation schedules for the uniformed members of the Division of Police; amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 799-2000 to provide for a three-tier formulary structure for prescription drugs and require mandatory mail direct refill restrictions for all maintenance drugs; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 378-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Chase Home Finance Corp., located at 328 Cross Street, for the purpose of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 379-2007 declaring it necessary to improve Bellfield Avenue between the termini of Eastholm Avenue and Robinwood Boulevard by constructing and reconstructing curbs, sanitary sewer house laterals and sanitary sewers and replacing private sanitary sewers; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 380-2007 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for emergency repairs to the outlet sewer from CSO Rack 29; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 381-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of Phase 2 of the public improvements to the Elizabeth Park Hope VI Redevelopment Area; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 382-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for maintenance of the interstate system within Akron's municipal corporation limits; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 383-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and installation of two main substation transformers for use at the Water Supply Plant; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 384-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and installation of a hydronic boiler at the Water Pollution Control Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 385-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of taser equipment; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 386-2007 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 727 Raymond Street to the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority in conjunction with their Edgewood Homes Hope VI application; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 387-2007 approving the sale of vacant City owned land on the northwest corner of Rhodes Avenue and Vernon Odom Boulevard to Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority in conjunction with their Edgewood Homes Hope VI application; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 388-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement or agreements with Akron-Summit County Public Library for the lease of 0.373 acres of City owned land on Kenmore Boulevard for the construction of a new library; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 389-2007 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of 14th Street, SW; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 390-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a Public Library at 2200 14th Street, S.W.; and declaring an emergency.
