

## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 23, 2007**

ORD. NO. 391-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 392-2007 expressing support for and approving the Reuse Plan for the Navy-Marine Corps Reserve Center at 800 Dan Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 393-2007 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Meccon, Inc. for emergency repairs to the fire suppression system water line at the Akron Global Business Accelerator; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 394-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of the Science, Math and Technology Community Learning Center at 199 South Broadway; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 395-2007 authorizing the signing of a Development Agreement between the City and FirstEnergy Properties, Inc., in connection with a project at its West Akron Campus; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 396-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with KeyBank for a linked deposit of City funds in support of the Heritage Home Loan Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 397-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest, temporary right-of-way easement, utility easement and work agreement easement in certain real property owned by S.E.T. Enterprises, LLC, An Ohio Limited Liability Company, located at 595 E. Tallmadge Ave., for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 398-2007 declaring it necessary to improve North Portage Path between the termini of Mark Drive and Barcelona Drive by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 399-2007 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement for funding of airport improvements through the Federal Aviation Administration's FY2007 Airport Improvement Grant Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 400-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of miscellaneous improvements to the storm water collection system at various locations; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 401-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the environmental remediation and cleanup of City-owned properties located in the Middlebury East Project Area; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 402-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of a roof replacement at the Incubator-Accelerator Building; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 403-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction and installation of lighting at Joy Park; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 404-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing of East Market Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 405-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Plas-Tanks Industries for the labor and materials to repair and reline two sodium hydroxide tanks at the Water Supply Plant; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 406-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement or agreements with Akron Public Schools for the lease of a portion of City owned land at 199 South Broadway for the construction of the Science, Math and Technology Community Learning Center; and declaring an emergency.
