

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 14, 2008

ORD. NO. 4-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to solicit proposals and to advertise for bids and to enter into contracts for the maintenance of various parks, traffic islands and miscellaneous City properties for 2008; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 5-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a flagpole telecommunications tower at 393 Storer Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 6-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit an oversized electronic message center (LED) sign at 2470 East Market Street (Ellet Branch); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 7-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit an oversized electronic message center (LED) sign at 600 Vernon Odom Boulevard (Odom Boulevard Branch Library); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 8-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the building line and parking requirements for the construction of a building addition at 255 Fountain Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 9-2008 approving and authorizing execution of a Contract for Sale of Land for Private Redevelopment with Main Street Partners LLC providing for the City's disposition of property and the redevelopment of property in accordance with the O'Neil's Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 10-2008 accepting the resignation of John Otterman from his Council-At-Large position on Council; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 11-2008 providing for and setting February 4, 2008 as the date of the election by Council to fill the At-Large vacancy created by the resignation of John Otterman; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 12-2008 repealing Resolution No. 485-2007 adopted September 24, 2007, which declared the necessity of improving certain sections of Dover Avenue, East Park Boulevard, Genoa Avenue, and Santee Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 13-2008 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of Elizabeth Parkway between the termini of Lods Street and the east end by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewers, sanitary sewer house laterals, storm sewers, storm sewer laterals, and water mains; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 14-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a mutual aid agreement with Cuyahoga Falls for mutual assistance, interchange, and use of fire protection, personnel, and equipment in situations where one department needs and requests the assistance of the other; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 15-2008 congratulating John Otterman on his appointment as State Representative from the 45th District and honoring him for his 16 years of public service on Akron City Council; and declaring an emergency.
