

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 11, 2008

ORD. NO. 57-2008 approving the sale of city-owned land located on the southwest corner of West Market Street and Eleanor Terrace to Van Devere Properties Limited Partnership; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 58-2008 accepting a dedication plat for Fairway Plaza Drive, north of West Market Street and west of Bryden Drive; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 59-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc., for the purchase of business automobile liability insurance coverage for all City vehicles and physical damage coverage for Fire Department vehicles and EMS units; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 60-2008 adopting the 2008 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, also known as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 61-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit an oversized electronic message center (LED) sign at 1187 Copley Road (Maple Valley Branch Library); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 62-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a three-unit Apartment House at 176 Hillman Road; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 63-2008 accepting the resignation of James Shealey from his 5th Ward Councilman position on Council; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 64-2008 providing for and setting March 3, 2008 as the date of the election by Council to fill the Ward 5 vacancy created by the resignation of James Shealey; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 65-2008 providing for the issuance and sale of a note in the principal amount of \$81,600, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving Bellfield Avenue between the termini of Eastholm Avenue and Robinwood Boulevard by constructing and reconstructing curbs, sanitary sewer house laterals and sanitary sewers and replacing private sanitary sewers; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 66-2008 providing for the issuance and sale of a note in the principal amount of \$117,700, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving Kenmore Boulevard between the termini of 11th Street and 20th Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete and brick sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof

drain pipes; installing street lighting; installing traffic signalization; installing water mains; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 67-2008 providing for the issuance and sale of a note in the principal amount of \$399,700, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving West Market Street between the termini of Pershing Avenue and Hawkins Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 68-2008 declaring it necessary to improve North Hawkins Avenue between the termini of West Market Street and Thurmont Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; repairing concrete pavement; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 69-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of Kenilworth Drive between the termini of Greenvale Avenue and Garman Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 70-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement to amend the lease of City owned land under Hangar B at the Akron Fulton Airport; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 71-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a grant agreement with the City of Cleveland for Edward Byrne Memorial Discretionary Grant Funding to be used to target violent crime in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 72-2008 amending and/or supplementing Title 11, Chapter 111, Section 111.05 "Renewal" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron by revising the registration expiration date for ambulance and emergency medical services; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 73-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Summit Medina Business Alliance, Inc., to maintain the operations of the Small Business Development Center and provide the local cash match for available state funding to support the Small Business Development Center for the 2007-2008 fiscal year; authorizing an expenditure of City funds; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 74-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by John H. Harris, located at 488 Vernon Odom Boulevard, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 75-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by John H. Harris, a vacant lot located on Martin

Place, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. ON. 76-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by John Henry Harris, located at 813 Martin Place, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 77-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by John Henry Harris, located at 817 Martin Place, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.
