

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 3, 2008

ORD. NO. 86-2008 authorizing the expenditure of funds for the purchase of savings bonds, food, and other items for the City of Akron Holocaust Commemoration on April 29, 2008; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 87-2008 accepting a vacation plat for an unnamed alley north of East Tallmadge Avenue, between North Main Street and Blaine Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 88-2008 accepting a dedication utility right-of-way plat for Cobb Alley from North Adolph Avenue to Nebraska Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 89-2008 accepting a vacation and dedicated utility right-of-way plat for the part of 4th Street, S.W. between Millway Street and West Wilbeth Road and a portion of Millway Street for a distance of 18.86 feet along the southern edge of the right-of-way from the eastern right-of-way line of 4th Street, S.W.; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 90-2008 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the HICKORY STREET PHASE II – UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 91-2008 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency. **(PLANNING)**

ORD. NO. 92-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract for the sale and removal of surplus logs; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 93-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Daktronics, Inc. for the maintenance of the scoreboard at Canal Park; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 94-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to request proposals for and enter into a contract for the management and operation of the snack bar at the H.K. Stubbs Justice Center; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 95-2008 granting to Charlie Thomas, his successors and assigns, the right to erect and maintain an awning extending into the South Main Street right-of-way, for property at 207 South Main Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 96-2008 approving the sale of City owned land to Rebecca Johnson and Patricia Maher; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 97-2008 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the WATERLOO ROAD TOWPATH TRAIL project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 98-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the SPAULDING COURT / SPAULDING STREET project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 99-2008 approving and authorizing the execution of a contract for sale for private redevelopment with Reventures, Ltd (“Redeveloper”), providing for the sale and redevelopment of property pursuant to the Ascot Urban Redevelopment Plan; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 100-2008 appointing Kenneth L. Jones to fill the vacancy in the Akron City Council Ward 5 position until the vacancy can be filled by elections at the next primary and general elections at which all electors of the City are eligible to vote; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 101-2008 approving the site plans of the Akron Public Schools to construct the Leggett Community Learning Center at 570 Allyn Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 102-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and two temporary easement interests in certain real property owned by Davood Haghighi, located at 2168 S. Main Street, for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM-SO Main Street Phase IV Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 103-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the renovation of the Hyre Park Tennis Courts; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 104-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of a pavilion in Davenport Park; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 105-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and planting of trees along City streets throughout 2008; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 106-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of traffic signalization improvements at the intersection of Buchtel Avenue and College Street; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency

ORD. NO. 107-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to submit a grant application and enter into a grant agreement with the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for funding from the Community Recycling Access Grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 108-2008 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements for funding of certain capital improvements through the Surface Transportation Program (“STP”) and Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (“CMAQ”) Program from the Federal Highway Administration (“FHWA”); committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 109-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with H.M. Miller Construction Co. for emergency repairs to the Mud Run 24 –inch sanitary force main; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 110-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in certain real property owned by John H. Harris, located at 757 Edgewood Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the Edgewood Hope VI-Phase 1 Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.
