

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 31, 2008

ORD. NO. 155-2008 allocating \$14,000 from the Cargill Salt Royalties Fund to the Kenmore Community Council for expenses associated with the 17th Annual Kenmore Community Days Festival which will commemorate the centennial of Kenmore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 156-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the N. HAWKINS AVENUE PAVEMENT REPAIR project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 157-2008 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the HICKORY STREET PHASE II – UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 158-2008 appointing Marco Sommerville, John Conti and James Shealey as members of the Akron-Bath-Copley joint township hospital district board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 159-2008 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with Oriana House, Inc. for one Misdemeanor Police Liaison position; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 160-2008 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$15,000.00 for an operating subsidy to Cascade Locks Park Association; declaring this expenditure of funds to be in the public interest and for a public purpose; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 161-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Ingersoll Building Corporation for the labor, equipment and materials to renovate the Women’s Restrooms at O’Neil’s Commons; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 162-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of Dresden Avenue between the termini of South Firestone Boulevard and Brown Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 163-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement; as a member of the Summit County Cold Case Task Force, with the Ohio Attorney General for funding to conduct “cold case” investigations where DNA evidence is involved; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 164-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by John Henry Harris, located at 813 Martin Place, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 165-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by John Henry Harris, located at 817 Martin Place, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 166-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by John H. Harris, a vacant lot located on Martin Place, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 167-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by John H. Harris, located at 488 Vernon Odom Boulevard, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 168-2008 expressing support for the Cities for Climate Protection Campaign sponsored by ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability and encouraging Keep Akron Beautiful to take a leadership role in promoting public awareness about the causes and impacts of climate change; and declaring an emergency.
