

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 12, 2008

ORD. NO. 236-2008 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement for funding of airport improvements through the State of Ohio's FY2009 Ohio Airport Improvement Grant Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 237-2008 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 117-2008 passed March 10, 2008 (the "Resolution of Necessity"), to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of Bowery Street and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity (2008 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 238-2008 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 118-2008 passed March 10, 2008 (the "Resolution of Necessity"), to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of 7th Street SW and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity (2008 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 239-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of Cromwell Drive and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 119-2008 passed March 10, 2008 (2008 Phase I Partial Depth Pavement Replacement Program); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 240-2008 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 120-2008 passed March 10, 2008 (the "Resolution of Necessity"), to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of 18th Street SW and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity (2008 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 241-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in Phase II of the 2008 Arterial Collector Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 242-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in Phase II of the 2008 Residential Resurfacing Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 243-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in Phase II of the 2008 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 244-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in daily operations of the Sanitation Department; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 245-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Novatny Electric Company for emergency replacement of the emergency generator and switchgear in the Cascade Parking Deck; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 246-2008 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase II Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 247-2008 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase II Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 248-2008 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase II Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 249-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the HELEN ARNOLD COMMUNITY CENTER project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 250-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the EAST HIGH COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 251-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the BROWNFIELD / XXTH CENTURY ASSESSMENT project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 252-2008 expressing support for the application by the Summit County Port Authority for Clean Ohio Assistance Funds for the environmental assessment of the existing Goodyear Headquarters Property; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 253-2008 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Development, for funding from the Clean Ohio

Assistance Fund for the environmental cleanup of 99 Seiberling Street, Goodyear
Redevelopment Project, in the City of Akron; and if funding is awarded, to enter into an
agreement to implement the cleanup; and declaring an emergency.
