

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 9, 2008

**ORD. NO. 279-2008** Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the labor and materials to extend the apparatus bay at Fire Station No. 9; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 280-2008** amending The Zoning Map by changing the Apartment House Use District (U2,H1,A3) Classification on property located on the east side of Adams Street and north of Day Street to a Hospital Use District (UHD,H5,A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 281-2008** amending The Zoning Map by changing the Single-Family Residence Use District (U1,H1,A1) Classification on property located on the west side of Ames Court and south of Hazel Street to a Hospital Use District (UHD,H5,A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 282-2008** amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 491-2005, passed September 26, 2005, which amended Ordinance 547-2004, passed October 4, 2004, which amended Ordinance No. 1000-1990, passed December 17, 1990, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of a barber shop on property at 591 East Waterloo Road by changing the address of the owner and amending condition (12) regarding signage; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 283-2008** amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 424-2007, passed September 10, 2007, which authorized a Conditional Use to establish a scrap iron, metal salvage and collection business on the north side of Hazel Street, west of the CSX Railroad right-of-way by changing the name of the owner; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 284-2008** accepting a vacation and dedication of utility right-of-way plat for the vacation of Nash Street from South Union Street (Brown Street) to Spicer Street, and for the vacation of and dedication as a utility right-of-way for Vine Street from South Union Street (Brown Street) to Spicer Street and South Union Street (Brown Street) from Vine Street to East Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 285-2008** approving the recommendations of the Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and/or cancellation of the enterprise zone and tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 286-2008** accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the N. HAWKINS AVENUE PAVEMENT REPAIR project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 287-2008** determining that the improvement to West Market Street between the termini of Waldorf Drive and Bryden Drive by relocating overhead utilities underground should be made; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 288-2008** determining that the improvement to East Market Street between the termini of South Main Street and Summit Street by constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing street lighting; and planting trees should be made; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 289-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Vanguard Utility Service, Inc., for the purchase and installation of an Automated Meter Reading System for commercial and industrial water meters and all fire service meters throughout the Akron water service area; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 290-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to West Market Street from Revere Road to Pershing and from Hawkins Avenue to Twin Oaks Road; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 291-2008** declaring it necessary to improve East Market Street between the termini of State Route 59 and Arlington Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 292-2008** declaring it necessary to improve Massillon Road between the termini of Oakes Drive and Massillon Service Drive, George Washington Boulevard between the termini of Springfield Lake Boulevard and Triplett Boulevard, Wilbeth Road between the termini of Allendale

Avenue and South Arlington Street and Triplett Boulevard between the termini of South Arlington Street and Hilbish Avenue by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 293-2008** declaring it necessary to improve North Street between the termini of North Howard Street and Furnace Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes and street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 294-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in daily operations of various divisions of the Department of Public Service; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 295-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of improvements to the South Main Street Bridge over the railroad and the 27<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge over Kenmore Boulevard; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 296-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of improvements to the landscaping along I-77 from Copley Road to State Route 21; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 297-2008** declaring it necessary to improve North Arlington Street between the termini of Hazel Street and Munson Street by constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and retaining walls; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.
