

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 8, 2008

ORD. NO. 399-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit an oversized sign at 106 South Main Street.

ORD. NO. 400-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of Manchester Road between the termini of West Thornton Street and East Avenue, Copley Road between the termini of Mercer Avenue and Edgewood Avenue, South Maple Street between the termini of Edgewood Avenue and Glendale Avenue and Glendale Avenue between the termini of South Maple Street and Rand Street by resurfacing; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 401-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to amend the contract with AMPCO System Parking to add the 401 South Main Street Lot; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 402-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction Co. for labor and materials for the emergency repair of the sanitary sewer lateral at 383 S. Arlington Street; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 403-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Sunbelt Transformer for the sale of surplus substation equipment which is no longer needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 404-2008 opposing and objecting to the application of O P Market, Inc. d.b.a. O P Market, 950 Copley Road, Akron, Ohio 44320, for a Class C1, C2, liquor permit now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 405-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a loan agreement with WMK, Inc., dba Mobility Works, to provide funds for the purpose of job creation and retention and to promote private investment and economic development; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 406-2008 authorizing a 120 day moratorium on the issuance of permits for the erection of any new outdoor advertising display; requesting the Planning Department and the Planning Commission to conduct a thorough study of the appropriate regulation of outdoor advertising displays and to initiate an amendment to the Zoning Code; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 407-2008 approving the Eastgate II Redevelopment Plan; making necessary findings in connections therewith; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 408-2008 authorizing the vacation of Middlebury Run Park and the return of the property to Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company; authorizing the Director of Public Service to accept various parcels of land from the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company and authorizing the transfer of said parcels to IRG Rubber City, LLC for developmental purposes; determining said land is not needed for municipal use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 409-2008 approving an Amendment to the Eastgate Urban Renewal Plan so as to designate additional property to be acquired within the existing plan area; to reaffirm the findings made in connection with the Urban Renewal Area; and declaring an emergency.
