

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 22, 2008

ORD. NO. 420-2008 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the MILL STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 421-2008 approving the sale of City owned land to Karl H. & Elizabeth A. Brenneman; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 422-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a Joint Funding Agreement with the U.S. Geological Survey for the period October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2011; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 423-2008 authorizing the Mayor to accept grant money in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the Fireman's Fund Insurance Company through their "Fireman's Fund Heritage" grant program and enter into a grant agreement therefore; and authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract to implement the grant agreement; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 424-2008 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a personal services contract with Gloria Dandridge for services as a clerical assistant for the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 425-2008 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 426-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estate in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for LAND BANKING purposes; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 427-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the EDGEWOOD REDEVELOPMENT AREA project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 428-2008 authorizing the donation of property to NEONA Properties, LLC ("NEONA"); finding such property is not needed for any public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 429-2008 amending Ordinance No. 134-2008, passed March 17, 2008, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2008; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 430-2008 amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, "Zoning Code", Section 153.140 "Definitions" and Section 153.305 "Residence Requirements" of the Code of

Ordinances of the City of Akron, by amending the definition of “Condominium housing” and by adding Subsection 153.305(B)(3) to allow fee-simple ownership of land under residential condominium dwelling units; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 431-2008 declaring the official intent and reasonable expectation of the City of Akron on behalf of the State of Ohio (borrower) to reimburse its capital fund for the Mill Street Bridge over CSX Railroad project with the proceeds of tax exempt debt of the State of Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 432-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Akron Public Schools for the Community Learning Centers After School Program to provide after school activities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 433-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in the divisions of Highway Maintenance, Parks Maintenance, and Street Cleaning; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 434-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to purchase two ed vehicles at public auction; authorizing payment therefore; authorizing the resale of these vehicles at public auction when they are no longer needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 435-2008 requesting the Director of Public Service to conduct a study on the feasibility of providing a Driveway Snow Removal service for Akron’s senior citizens; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 436-2008 amending and/or supplementing the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron by revising certain sections in Chapter 111 regulating entertainment device arcades; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 437-2008 naming the triangular shaped parcel of land at West Market Street and White Pond Drive “Judith Bear Isroff Park; and declaring an emergency.
