

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 24, 2008

ORD. NO. 514-2008 authorizing the Director of Health to apply for grant funds and enter into a grant agreement with the Summit County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board for funding of the Counseling Services and Alcoholism Division's outpatient treatment, juvenile court intervention and prevention programs for the year 2009; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 515-2008 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 93 – 8.50 / MANCHESTER ROAD project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 516-2008 authorizing the Mayor to submit an application to the Ohio Board of Building Standards for approval of an administrative rule change to provide that the County of Summit Department of Building Standards shall exercise enforcement authority of Part Thirteen of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Building Code," which incorporates the 2006 Residential Code of Ohio and the 2007 Ohio Building Code, within the City of Akron; authorizing an agreement for such enforcement between the City of Akron and Summit County; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 517-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a 40-unit town home development on the east side of George Washington Boulevard, south of East Waterloo Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 518-2008 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Single-Family Residence Use District (U1,H1,A1) Classification, the Apartment House Use District (U2,H1,A3) Classification and the Retail Business Use District (U3,H1,A2) Classification on property located on the east side of South Main Street, south of Firestone Boulevard, north of East Wilbeth Road and west of the Sage Avenue terminus to a Retail Business Use District (U3,H4,A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 519-2008 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Commercial Use District (U4, H2, A3) Classification and the Apartment House Use District (U2, H1, A3) Classification on property located on the west side of South Main Street, east of Firestone Parkway and south of Firestone Boulevard to a Retail Business Use District (U3, H4, A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 520-2008 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Commercial Use District (U4, H2, A3) Classification, the Apartment House Use District (U2, H1, A3) Classification and the Retail Business Use District (U3, H1, A2) Classification on property located on the west side of South Main Street, east of Firestone Parkway and north of West Wilbeth Road to a Government Use District (UG, H1, A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 521-2008 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Ordinary Industry Use District (U5, H4, A2) Classification on 59.81 acres of property located on the south side of West

Wilbeth Road, east of the Ohio and Erie Canal and west of Basswood Street to a Government Use District (UG, H1, A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 522-2008 accepting the eligibility report for the South Main-Wilbeth Urban Renewal Area; approving the South Main – Wilbeth Urban Renewal and Firestone Park Redevelopment Area Plan; and making necessary findings in connections therewith.

ORD. NO. 523-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of a new fire alarm and emergency notification system at the CitiCenter Building; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 524-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of a pump testing system at the Fire Maintenance Facility; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 525-2008 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of Indian Trail in the City by constructing curb, paving, driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes, storm sewer and water main and appurtenances thereto; all in accordance with a petition submitted by the property owner of 620 Indian Trail; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 526-2008 authorizing certain benefits to bargaining unit members who presently work in the Building Inspection or Plans and Permits Divisions, and as a result of the transfer of enforcement authority from the City to the County, are later hired by the County of Summit Department of Building Standards; authorizing certain benefits to non-bargaining employees who presently work in the Building Inspection Division and are later hired by the County of Summit Department of Building Standards; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 527-2008 approving the historic designation of the Richard Howe House at 47 West Exchange Street as a Historic Landmark; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 528-2008 expressing opposition to the recall effort announced last week and expressing support for Mayor Donald L. Plusquellic; and declaring an emergency.
