

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 12, 2009

ORD. NO. 12-2009 accepting a dedication plat for Penny Lane Extension westward to Brown Street a distance of 100.34 feet in length; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 13-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to install signage and make site improvements to property at 1490 Vernon Odom Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 14-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a collision repair/auto body repair shop at 1115 Triplett Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 15-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an addition to the gasoline service station at 1705 Diagonal Road; and declaring an emergency.
