

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 8, 2009

ORD. NO. 246-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the removal and replacement of the fence along Hands Lateral; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 247-2009 amending and/or supplementing Title 19 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to revise Section 197.302 to adopt new flood hazard maps; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 248-2009 accepting a sewer easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the MARIGOLD / ROCKFORD / SAGE STORM IMPROVEMENTS project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 249-2009 authorizing the expenditure of funds to implement Health Works Akron, an employee wellness initiative; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 250-2009 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with public improvements and public services for the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District in accordance with Ordinance No. 554-2008 which approved the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District and the Plan for Services to be provided by the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District, Inc., all when and where necessary, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 251-2009 determining to proceed with the improvement of Manchester Road between the termini of West Waterloo Road and West Wilbeth Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; providing street lighting; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 252-2009 determining to proceed with the improvement of Raymond Street between the termini of Vernon Odom Boulevard and Euclid Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, water mains and storm sewers; and installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 253-2009 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into an agreement for a Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant administered by the United States Bureau of Justice Assistance; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 254-2009 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into an agreement for a Justice Assistance Grant administered through the Bureau of Justice Assistance to develop and enhance programs to improve the criminal justice system; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 255-2009 authorizing the Director of Finance to donate \$10,000 to Grandparents Against Sex Predators ("G.A.S.P.") to help improve child safety by helping to find missing/abducted children, assisting local law enforcement in predator-related initiatives and

projects, and educating the community on ways to recognize and prevent child abuse by sexual predators; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. 256-2009 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Development for funding for use in completing public roadway improvements on Wilbeth Road, Firestone Parkway, and South Main Street; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 257-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a permanent easement in certain real property owned by Sam Winer Motors, Inc. located at 3417 E. Waterloo Road, Akron, Ohio 44312, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer, or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in conjunction with the Waterloo Road Wright Sewer JEDD Project; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 258-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate permanent easements in certain real property owned by the Estate of Harvey Winer and Shirley Zetzer aka Selma Zetzer located at 3417 E. Waterloo Road, Akron, Ohio 44312, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer, or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in conjunction with the Waterloo Road Wright Sewer JEDD Project; and declaring an emergency.
