

## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 6, 2009**

**ORD. NO. 289-2009** amending The Zoning Map by changing the Apartment House Use District (U2, H1,A3) Classification and the Single-Family Residence Use District (U1,H1,A1) Classification on property located on the north side of Philip Avenue, east of North Adams Street to a Hospital Use District (UHD,H5,A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 290-2009** accepting a vacation plat for a portion of an unnamed alley on the north side of Wheeler Street, west of Brown Street; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 291-2009** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an optical test tower at 920 George Washington Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 292-2009** authorizing a Conditional Use to convert a retail building to a storage facility at 1561 Brittain Road; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 293-2009** authorizing a Conditional Use to place an oversized electronic changeable copy (LED) sign at 1490 Vernon Odom Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 294-2009** authorizing a Conditional Use to place a digital changeable copy (LED) high rise sign on property at 43 Pruitt Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NOL. 295-2009** Ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application with the State of Ohio for the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 296-2009** authorizing an amendment to the 2008 Consolidated Plan and Community Development/Home Program, to include the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 (NSP 2) as an eligible activity; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 297-2009** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of improvements to South Main Street from Boxwood Avenue to Dartmore Avenue and 517' north of Wilbeth Road to Firestone Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 298-2009** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials to rebuild the Primary Tank skimmer system at the Water Pollution Control Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 299-2009** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract for the purchase of a replacement sewer television camera and assembly parts for use by the Sewer Maintenance Division; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 300-2009** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Workman Industrial Services for the emergency repair of a 60-inch sluice gate in the High Lift Pump Station at the Water Supply Plant; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.
