

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 19, 2009

ORD. NO. 437-2009 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Thermo Fisher Scientific Environmental Instruments, Inc. for the purchase of a Continuous PM2.5 Monitor; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 438-2009 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a personal services contract with Gloria Dandridge for services as a clerical assistant for the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 439-2009 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City's participation in miscellaneous organizations, associations and agencies; and declaring an emergency. (9/14/09)

ORD. NO. 440-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an addition within the side yard area at 555 Piccadilly Circle, and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 441-2009 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Health, and/or the Director of Finance to purchase miscellaneous supplies and repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions of the departments of the City for a period of one (1) year; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 442-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an auto parts store on the east side of South Arlington Street, north of Jenkins Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 443-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized sign at 1430 Goodyear Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 444-2009 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Fiscal Officer.

RES. NO. 445-2009 declaring it necessary to improve Hilbish Avenue between the termini of Triplett Boulevard and East Market Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 446-2009 amending Resolution No. 428-2009, passed October 5, 2009, by correcting the number of installment payments for the special assessments provided for therein; repealing Section 8 of said resolution as it was passed on October 5, 2009; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 447-2009 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Governor's Highway Safety Office for funding from the FFY 2010 High Visibility Enforcement Overtime Grant; authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 448-2009 authorizing the Mayor to apply for funds and enter into an agreement with the “2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods” grant administered through the State of Ohio, Office of Criminal Justice Services; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 449-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest and temporary easement interest in certain real property owned by SUR&R Auto Parts Inc., located at 1969 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 450-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest and temporary easement interest in certain real property owned by Pauline Hallamay located at 2004 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 451-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest and temporary easement interest in certain real property owned by Hallamay Color Lab Inc., located at 2008 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 452-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest and temporary easement interest in certain real property owned by Speedway Superamerica, LLC located at 2129 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 453-2009 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the SUM. S. MAIN STREET ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 454-2009 authorizing the Mayor to file an application with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Supportive Housing Program for funds for the homeless; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 455-2009 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Rev. John Hosea and Zelma Yarborough (deceased) located at 250 North Howard Street, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Hickory Corridor/Cascade Locks Renewal Area Plan; and declaring an emergency.
