

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 16, 2009

ORD. NO. 487-2009 amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, “Zoning Code”, Section 153.265 “Prohibited Accessory Uses” in residence districts, by deleting Subsection (A) prohibiting certain accessory uses and structures, including “spite fences”; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 488-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an employee parking lot for the Akron Zoological Park at 545-573 Euclid Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 489-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the operation and maintenance of City-owned gas and/or oil wells; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 490-2009 levying special assessments for the improvement of North Portage Path between the termini of Mark Drive and Barcelona Drive by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 491-2009 declaring it necessary to improve Frank Boulevard between the termini of White Pond Drive and Ayers Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 492-2009 amending and/or supplementing Title 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron by amending and/or supplementing 111.351 “Hours of Sale” concerning sales in the Community Entertainment District; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 493-2009 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into an agreement with the Barberton Health Department and the Summit County Health District to enroll women, infants, and children in the Special Supplemental Nutrition Grant Program funded by the Ohio Department of Health; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 494-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by South Main Street Properties, LLC, located at 1769 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 495-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by Andrew W. and Terry Lynn Pfaff, located at 2015 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing

roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 496-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by Robert C. and Tami L. Asher, located at 2018 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 497-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by Young Realty Co., Inc., located at 2036 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.
