

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 30, 2009

ORD. NO. 507-2009 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with The Cardinal Group for the emergency repair of the Greystone Hall roof; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 508-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Hattie's Café, Fountain and Gifts to operate vending machines in City-owned buildings; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 509-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to file an application and enter into a grant agreement for funding from the Safe Routes to School Program through the Ohio Department of Transportation; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 510-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of Summit Lake Baseball Field Dugouts; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 511-2009 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into an agreement with the Mansfield-Ontario-Richland County Health Department to provide disease intervention services to clients; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 512-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 22.34 acres of City-owned land located on the east side of South Arlington Street, south of Waterloo Road, and approximately 3.64 acres of street right-of-way along portions of Chaffin Road, South Arlington Street, and Waterloo Road to Ohio Valley Energy Systems for completion of the "Flasck Unit No. 1" gas/oil well drilling unit unitization; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 513-2009 congratulating Police Chief Craig Gilbride on the occasion of his retirement and thanking him for his 32 years of dedicated service; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 514-2009 amending and/or supplementing the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to provide equal opportunity and prohibit discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 515-2009 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Health, and/or the Director of Finance to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of materials and services needed by the various City departments for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 516-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a Technical Center and parking garage at 10 South Firestone Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 517-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by James Ricardo Keen, located at 1855 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 518-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by Thomas R. and Shannon M. Milner, located at 1865 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 519-2009 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest and temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by Millennium Property Holdings LLC, located at 2074 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 520-2009 approving and confirming the appointment of Tina Merlitti to the Board of Directors of the Bath-Akron-Fairlawn and the Copley-Akron Joint Economic Development Districts; and declaring an emergency.
