

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 21, 2009

ORD. NO. 542-2009 amending and/or supplementing Title 5, Chapter 50 “Sewers”, Sections 50.22 and 50.33 to revise sewerage service charges and the use of sewerage services charges; authorizing the Director of Public Service to develop a discount rate adjustment program for low-income Akron residents; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 543-2009 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with Oriana House, Inc. for one police liaison for the Misdemeanor unit and two police liaisons for the Domestic Violence unit; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 544-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 2.37 acres of City-owned land located on Frederick Boulevard, Seward Avenue and Nome Avenue, and approximately 7.11 acres of street right-of-way along Park Drive, and portions of Copley Road, Pickford Avenue, Juneau Avenue, Valdes Avenue Frederick Avenue, Seward Avenue, Nome Avenue, Little Street, Cordova Avenue, and unnamed alleys west of Cordova Avenue, between Pickford Avenue and Nome Avenue to Ohio Valley Energy Systems for completion of the “Mountain of the Lord Unit No. 1” gas/oil well drilling unit unitization; and declaring an emergency.
