

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 11, 2010

RES. NO. 1-2010 congratulating and honoring the University of Akron Men's Soccer Team ("Zips") and their coaches on their extraordinary winning season and remarkable performance in the NCAA Men's National Soccer Tournament; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 2-2010 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a drive thru addition at 1354 Vernon Odom Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 3-2010 setting the time for regular meetings of Akron City Council; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 4-2010 authorizing and requesting the Summit County Fiscal Officer to make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax receipts to be received in calendar year 2010 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 5-2010 declaring it necessary to improve Overlook Drive between the termini of Clearview Avenue and the northern terminus by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 6-2010 determining to proceed with the improvement of Baird Street between the termini of Brown Street and Burkhardt Avenue and Kipling Street between the termini of Brown Street and Burkhardt Avenue by resurfacing; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 7-2010 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of Joy Park play sets; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 8-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to I-76 from the Central Interchange to Tallmadge Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 9-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of the Brittain Road Ramp over Market; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 10-2010 approving and confirming the appointments of Mayor Donald Plusquellic, Ken Jones and Diane Miller-Dawson as trustees to the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Board and Paul Barnett, Robert Harris and Cindy Donel as their respective alternates; and declaring an emergency.
