

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 17, 2010

ORD. NO. 156-2010 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the LAND BANKING project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 157-2010 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with non-profit organizations, for the provision of public services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of programs under the Consolidated Plan for the year 2010; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 158-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$35,850,000 in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of paying the costs of various capital improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 159-2010 accepting the honorary designation of a section of Olive Street, between North Main Street and North Howard Street, as “Dr. Bob’s Way,” and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 160-2010 declaring it necessary to improve various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and at when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 161-2010 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the City of Tallmadge regarding matters involving law enforcement; and declaring an emergency.
