

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 7, 2010

ORD. NO. 175-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 14.29 acres of City-owned land and street right-of-way on portions of Dahlgreen Drive, Ericsson Avenue, Kelly Avenue, and Puritan Drive, for completion of the “Blimp City No. 1D” gas/oil well drilling unit unitization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 176-2010 accepting a sewer easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the Massillon Avenue Sewer project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 177-2010 accepting conveyance (s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the Edgewood Redevelopment Area project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 178-2010 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the C.D. Land Banking project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 179-2010 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an addition at 539 South Arlington Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 180-2010 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with non-profit neighborhood based organizations for the provision of services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of the Neighborhood Partnership program; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 181-2010 approving the sale of City owned land to East Akron Neighborhood Development Corp; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 182-2010 approving the sale of City owned land to Westside Neighborhood Development Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 183-2010 approving the sale of City owned land to Neighborhood Development Services; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 184-2010 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls; and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2009 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 185-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of City sidewalks; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 186-2010 declaring it necessary to improve North Firestone Boulevard between the termini of Grant Street and Girard Street by constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; and installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 187-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Toter Incorporated for the purchase of recycle/trash carts; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 188-2010 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, with Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) vendors, for the purchase of fire hydrants in conjunction with the Ohio Public Works Commission contract requirements; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 189-2010 authorizing the Mayor to file an application for a grant and enter into an agreement for funding from the 2010 Justice Assistance Grant administered through the State of Ohio, Office of Criminal Justice Services to aid in law enforcement and security in the City of Akron; authorizing the expenditure of local funds in support of this grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 190-2010 authorizing the Mayor to apply for an enter into an agreement for the 2010 Justice Assistance Grant administered through the Bureau of Justice Assistance to develop and enhance programs to improve the criminal justice system; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 191-2010 authorizing the Mayor to execute the Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding for Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing; and declaring an emergency.
