

## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 27, 2010**

**ORD. NO. 305-2010** authorizing the Mayor to submit an application and enter into an agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for funding from the Brownfield's Revolving Loan Fund Grant Program to capitalize a revolving fund and to make loans and provide subgrants to carry out cleanup activities at Brownfield sites; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 306-2010** approving the sale of City owned land to Habitat for Humanity of Summit County; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 307-2010** accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the C.D. LAND BANKING project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 308-2010** accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the EDGEWOOD REDEVELOPMENT AREA project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 309-2010** declaring the official intent and reasonable expectation of the City of Akron on behalf of the State of Ohio to reimburse its capital fund for the Carroll Street, Smith Road/Riverview Road Roundabout, and Spicer Street & Kirn Street projects with the proceeds of tax exempt debt of the State of Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 310-2010** authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 29.96 acres of City-owned land and street right-of-way along Stockbridge Road and West Fairlawn Boulevard for completion of the "John V. Frank Units No. 1D and No. 2D" gas/oil well drilling unit unitizations; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 311-2010** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of miscellaneous materials and services needed by the Department of Public Safety for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 312-2010** authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Education, for After School Program grants; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 313-2010** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the repair of fire protective gear through October 1, 2011, with a two year renewal option; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 314-2010** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with AT&T Mobility for the purchase of cellular network equipment for mobile data terminals, without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 315-2010** expressing support for Issues 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 on the ballot in November and urging the residents of the City of Akron to support these Charter Amendments; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 316-2010** urging Congressman Tim Ryan, Senators George Voinovich and Sherrod Brown, and Todd Hawkins, District Manager for the Northern Ohio District of the United States Postal Service, to stop the closure of the East Akron Post Office servicing zip code 44305; and declaring an emergency.
