

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 18, 2010

ORD. NO. 322-2010 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the C.D. LAND BANKING project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 323-2010 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Logos Communications Inc. without the formality of advertising for bids, for the WPCS telephone system upgrade; approving payment thereof; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 324-2010 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a three-unit apartment at 512 East Buchtel Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 325-2010 authorizing a Conditional Use to install a Satellite Uplink Antenna at 1520 South Arlington Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 326-2010 authorizing a Conditional Use to install two brine wells west of Manchester Road, south of the Tuscarawas River; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 327-2010 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Fiscal Officer.

ORD. NO. 328-2010 waiving the provisions of Title 3, Chapter 35, Sections 35.01, 35.14, 35.15 and 35.16 to permit an employee to carry-over hours of unused paid leave, vacation leave and personal days and authorizing the Mayor to negotiate cost saving terms; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 329-2010 amending and/or supplementing Section 35.06 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to address longevity compensation for calendar year 2010; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 330-2010 amending and/or supplementing Section 35.15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to address the longevity compensation for sworn personnel of the Police Division for the calendar year 2010; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 331-2010 amending and/or supplementing Title 3, Chapter 35, Section 35.02 "Working Hours" approving changes in holiday pay for bargaining unit members in the Fraternal Order of Police, Akron Lodge #7; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 332-2010 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a temporary easement interest and a fee simple interest in certain real property owned by Pamela J. Looney, located at 1735 South Main Street, for the purposes of constructing, expanding, widening and/or repairing South Main Street, which is open to the public without charge in conjunction with the SUM/South Main Street Roadway Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, expanding, widening and/or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 333-2010 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate fee simple interests in certain real property owned by Roy E. Simpson and Deborah J. Simpson, located at 673 Mallison Avenue, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 334-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the sealing of pavement cracks on SR8; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 335-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to West Market Street from Revere Road to Pershing and from Hawkins Avenue to Twin Oaks Road; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 336-2010 establishing October 24-30, 2010 as Lead Poisoning Prevention Week and encouraging Akron parents and grandparents who care for children under the age of six to ensure a lead safe environment and participate in the City of Akron's Lead Prevention programs; and declaring an emergency.
