

## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 22, 2010**

**ORD. NO. 387-2010** accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the C.D. LAND BANKING project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 388-2010** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for deck replacement of two structures on IR-76; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 389-2010** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with H.M. Miller Construction Company for emergency repair of an 8-inch sanitary sewer at the intersection of Exchange Street and Water Street; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 390-2010** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Cavanaugh Building Corporation for emergency renovation of the first floor of the Municipal Building to relocate the Housing Rehabilitation Division and the addition of a Planning conference room on the fourth floor; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 391-2010** Resolution declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Annette Mitchell and Bryan C. Spruce located at 701 Mallison Avenue, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 392-2010** declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Kelley Dixon located at 685 Mallison Avenue, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence of blight and furthering the objectives of the Edgewood Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 393-2010** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials to refurbish Fire and EMS vehicles; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 394-2010** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Brite Computers for premium maintenance and support coverage of net motion mobility software, without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.
