

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 31, 2011

ORD. NO. 15-2010 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after requesting proposals, for property insurance coverage for large mobile equipment valued over \$50,000, and in the event of proposal failure, authorizing negotiations of said insurance policy; approving specifications thereof; and declaring an emergency. **(BUDGET AND FINANCE)**

ORD. NO. 16-2011 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Mallison Avenue, south of Berry Avenue and north of West Bartges Street; and declaring an emergency. **(PLANNING)**

ORD. NO. 17-2011 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the Sum-Massillon Road Improvement project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency. **(PLANNING)**

ORD. NO. 18-2011 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the improvement of the I-76/I-77 Main Street Broadway Street Interchange; and declaring an emergency. **(PUBLIC SERVICE)**

ORD. NO. 19-2011 authorizing the Mayor to execute a Term Sheet relating to the acquisition, construction, improvement and equipping of new North American Tire Headquarters and Global Headquarters facilities for the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company located in the City; authorizing a Cooperative Agreement, a Development Agreement, and other necessary documents upon terms consistent with such Financing Term Sheet; and declaring an emergency. **(ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & JOB CREATION)**

ORD. NO. 20-2011 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Board of Education of the Akron City School District for the Community Learning Centers After School Program to provide after school activities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 21-2011 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City's participation in miscellaneous organizations, associations and agencies; and declaring an emergency.
