

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 15, 2013

ORD. NO. 103-2013 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Mull/Frank Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the Municipal Urban Redevelopment Tax Equivalent Fund, providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 and 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 104-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the County of Summit for construction seal and crack filling; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 105-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the office of the Purchasing Agent, for the purchase of a 50 HP main gearbox for the Water Pollution Control Division; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 106-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the office of the Purchasing Agent, for filter media removal and replacement, sphere removal and replacement, power washing, inspection, and painting of filter boxes at the Akron Water Plant; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 107-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Sulzer to remove, inspect, rebuild and re-install the high service pump #3 at the Akron Water Plant, without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 108-2013 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate fee simple interests, a permanent sewer easement, permanent utility easements, permanent aerial easements and temporary construction easements in certain real property owned by General Street Business Park Ltd., located on Seiberling Street and Englewood Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/Englewood Avenue Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 109-2013 declaring it necessary to improve Firestone Parkway between the termini of Wilbeth Road and Firestone Boulevard between the termini of Firestone Parkway and South Main Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and sanitary sewers; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 110-2013 determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 111-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after obtaining proposals, for the design and rehabilitation of Cascade Plaza; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 112-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service, after accepting proposals, to enter into contracts to replace the dectron system at the Balch Street Fitness Center; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 113-2013 urging the United States Congress to study the use of drones and, if necessary, to revise the policy permitting the domestic use of drones; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 114-2013 opposing “right to work” laws and the “Workplace Freedom” Constitutional Amendment; supporting fair labor practices to support working families and the economy of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.
