

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 22, 2013

ORD. NO. 115-2013 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Kenmore Construction for the emergency repair of paved drainage gutter on I-76; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 116-2013 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction for the emergency repair of the Falmouth sanitary sewer; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 117-2013 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Kenmore Construction for emergency repair of two parapet walls located on the All America Bridge and the Home Avenue Bridge over Beatrice Drive; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 118-2013 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 119-2013 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the University Square Urban Renewal Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund, providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Akron City School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 120-2013 authorizing an amendment to the 2012 Consolidated Plan and Community Development/HOME Program to authorize the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Section 108 Loan application for the Mayflower Manor Development; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary agreements for the operation and term of the activities; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 121-2013 approving and confirming the reappointment of Sidney C. Foster, Jr., to the Civil Service Commission; and declaring an emergency.
