

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 29, 2013

ORD. NO. 122-2013 accepting the donation of sewer and utility easements for property needed for the CSO Rack 15 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 123-2013 authorizing the purchase of property for the CSO Rack 15 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 124-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for spot paving on Interstate Routes 76 and 77; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 125-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the replacement of the chlorine dioxide generator and delivery system located at the Water Supply Plant; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 126-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the replacement of water mains and to extend water mains in existing service areas; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 127-2013 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for a loan from the Water Supply Revolving Loan Fund to fund the 2013 Water Main Replacement Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 128-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to repair an 800 HP electric blower motor used to operate the number 4 centrifugal blower; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 129-2013 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$15,000.00 for an operating subsidy to Cascade Locks Park Association; declaring this expenditure of funds to be in the public interest and for a public purpose; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 130-2013 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with non-profit neighborhood based organizations for the provision of services in order to carry out the Neighborhood Partnership Program; and declaring an emergency.
