

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 13, 2013

ORD. NO. 146-2013 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the South Broadway/Exchange Urban Renewal Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund, providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Akron City School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 147-2013 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into contracts with H.M. Miller Construction, Hanson Pipe and Precast, and Pure Technologies for emergency repair and inspection services due to a water main rupture located on West North Street; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 148-2013 declaring it necessary to improve Perkins Street between the termini of Howard Street and State Route 8 by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 149-2013 approving the sale of 2.2 acres of City-owned land located at 1240 Triplett Boulevard, to Briarwood Properties, Inc., determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 150-2013 approving and confirming the appointment of Marco Sommerville to the Summit County Combined General Health District Board of Health; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 151-2013 opposing an Amendment to H. B. 59, the Ohio House of Representatives’ 2013-2014 Biennial Budget Bill, which would prohibit Ohio colleges and universities from charging students out-of-state tuition if the institution assists students with voting in the state; urging the Ohio Senate and Governor to act to eliminate this provision from the final version of the 2013-2014 State Biennial Budget; and declaring an emergency.
