

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 11, 2013

**ORD. NO. 32-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for repair and painting services for the Crosier Street elevated water storage tank; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 33-2013** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an addition at 582 South Arlington Street; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 34-2013** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a multi-family student housing development on property at 80 East Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 35-2013** adopting the 2013 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, also known as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 36-2013** authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$10,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay expenses associated with the settlement of health care claims, whether by reserve or otherwise, and the City's portion of the costs of maintaining its self-insurance program for employee health care benefits; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 37-2013** levying special assessments for the improvement of Perkins Street and certain other streets between certain termini (2012 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 38-2013** levying special assessments for the improvement of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and certain other streets between certain termini (2012 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 39-2013** levying special assessments for the improvement of 6<sup>th</sup> Street SW and certain other streets between certain termini (2012 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 40-2013** levying special assessments for the improvement of Lownsdale Avenue between certain termini (2012 Phase I Partial Depth Pavement Replacement Program) by paving such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.
