

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 8, 2013

ORD. NO. 210-2013 accepting a dedication plat for a utility right-of-way from the east end of Elizabeth Parkway to East North Street for Cascade Village East; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 211-2013 authorizing the purchase of property on Beulah Avenue in the City of Akron, for C.D. Land Banking purposes; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 212-2013 authorizing the purchase of property on Evans Avenue for the CSO Rack 12 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 213-2013 authorizing the purchase of property at 32 Cole Place for the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 214-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for maintenance of the Interstates located within the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 215-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for spillway improvements to the Mogadore Reservoir, LaDue Reservoir, East Branch Reservoir and Lake Rockwell; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 216-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of the CSO Rack 15 Storage Basin and related improvements; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 217-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for improvements to the Johnston Street Water Pump Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 218-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for a grant to fund the Urban Tree Canopy Study; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 219-2013 approving the amendment of the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan to include the addition of the Southwest Summit Council of Governments; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 220-2013 approving the Citizen Participation Plan, including applications and certifications for the Community Development Block Grant (hereinafter Community Development), the HOME Investment partnership (hereinafter HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Programs.

ORD. NO. 221-2013 authorizing the issuance of notes of the City to the Ohio Air Quality Development authorizing the maximum principal amount of \$5,000,000 under Section 717.02 of the Ohio Revised Code to finance the costs of an “energy conservation measure” as defined in Section 717.02 of the Ohio Revised Code; authorizing and approving related documents and matters; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 222-2013 approving the recommendations of the Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and/or cancellation of tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 223-2013 establishing the honorary designation of a section of Olive Street, between North Main Street and Butler Street, as “Frank Waters Way,” and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 224-2013 determining to proceed with the improvement of Perkins Street between the termini of Howard Street and State Route 8 by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.
