

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 7, 2013

ORD. NO. 299-2013 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the office of the Purchasing Agent, for upgrades to the digital audio recording equipment in the Akron Municipal courtrooms; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 300-2013 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after accepting informal sealed bids, for the purchase of uniform materials for the Fire Division; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 301-2013 amending Ordinance No. 63-2013, passed March 11, 2013 and Ordinance No. 227-2013, passed July 15, 2013, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2013 and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 302-2013 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio for funding from the FY 2014 High Visibility Enforcement Overtime Grant; authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 303-2013 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$6,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of constructing, reconstructing, renovating and otherwise improving Cascade Plaza and the Cascade Plaza Parking Garage; approving a Development Agreement in furtherance thereof; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 304-2013 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 305-2013 requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2013 payable in 2014 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 306-2013 declaring it necessary to improve Englewood Avenue between the termini of Wigley Street and Massillon Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, and water mains; installing water service connections, sanitary sewer house laterals, and roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 307-2013 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, for a dehumidifier system at the CitiCenter Athletic Club; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 308-2013 expressing support for Issues 1, 2, 3 and 4 on the ballot in November and urging the residents of the City to support these Issues to keep the City strong and vibrant; and declaring an emergency.
