

AKRON, OHIO COUNCIL
ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 18, 2013

ORD. NO. 335-2013 authorizing the purchase of property and accepting the donation of a sewer easement for the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 336-2013 purchasing a utility easement for property needed for the CSO Retention Tank #2 project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 337-2013 accepting the eligibility report for the Furnace Street Urban Renewal Area, approving the Furnace Street Urban Renewal Plan; and making necessary findings in connections therewith.

ORD. NO. 338-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to erect three ground signs at 476 Mull Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 339-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a Laundromat and parking at 804 Copley Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 340-2013 providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2014 through March 31, 2014; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 341-2013 authorizing the purchase of property for the CSO Rack 14 Storage Basin Project; and declaring and emergency.

ORD. NO. 342-2013 authorizing the purchase of properties for the Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 343-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Bell Equipment Company for the rental of equipment for the 2013 Leaf Removal Program; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 344-2013 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) for a loan to provide funding for replacing the cap on the Main Outfall to the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 345-2013 accepting the resignation of Councilman Bruce Kilby from the office of Councilman for the Second Ward of the City of Akron; expressing the appreciation of the Council for Councilman Kilby's services as Second Ward Councilman; and declaring an emergency.
