

AKRON, OHIO COUNCIL
ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 25, 2013

ORD. NO. 346-2013 authorizing the Mayor to search for, identify and submit applications for grant funding from the federal government for funds to create and operate a Neighborhood Mobile Resource Center; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 347-2013 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Liberta Construction without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Mull Avenue and First Energy intersection; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 348-2013 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the repair of structural fire fighting protective clothing (fire turn out coats and pants) for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 349-2013 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract to provide comprehensive residential alcohol-drug treatment at Interval Brotherhood Home; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 350-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a gravel parking lot with a zero building line setback at 2655 Akron-Peninsula Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 351-2013 amending The Zoning Map as referred to in Section 153.220 and The Zoning Code as referred to in Section 153.1000-150 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron, 2004, to establish a Planned Development District (UPD-48) to permit apartment, limited business, retail, and commercial uses on approximately 84 acres of land along Firestone Parkway generally bounded by Steiner Avenue to the north and Wilbeth Road to the south; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 352-2013 authorizing the purchase of property at 866 Kenmore Boulevard for the Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 353-2013 approving and authorizing the execution of a contract for sale of land for private redevelopment with Vadxx Energy, LLC, or its designee ("Redeveloper"), providing for the sale and redevelopment of property pursuant to the Arlington/Kelly Urban Renewal Plan; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 354-2013 determining to proceed with the improvement of Englewood Avenue between the termini of Wigley Street and Massillon Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, and water mains; installing water service connections, sanitary sewer house laterals, and roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 355-2013 supporting local small business by encouraging participation in Small Business Saturday on November 30, 2013 and declaring an emergency.
