

AKRON, OHIO COUNCIL

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 2, 2013

ORD. NO. 356-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the separation of the combined sewer in the Rack 13 tributary area; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 357-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for relocation of a City waterline along SR 18; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 358-2013 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements for federal funding of certain capital improvements through the Surface Transportation Program (“STP”), and the Transportation Alternatives Program (“TAP”) administered by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (“AMATS”); committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 359-2013 providing for the continued ward representation of all residents of the City of Akron by making the effective date of the ward boundaries December 1, 2013 and amending Ordinance No. 357-2012 and 170-2013; appointing James P. Hurley III to fill the vacancy in the Ward 2 position for the term ending December 31, 2013; appointing Rich Swirsky to fill the vacancy in the Ward 1 position created by the appointment of James P. Hurley III to the Ward 2 position for the term ending December 31, 2013; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 360-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a building addition at 240 North Portage Path; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 361-2013 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Pete T. Georgekopoulos, and located at 1004 East Market Street, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the CSO Racks 5 and 7 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 362-2013 directing the appropriation of a permanent utility easement interest in real property owned by Enlarging Arts, Inc., and located at 145 Tarbell Street for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and water line purposes in connection with the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; and declaring an emergency.
