ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 3, 2014:

ORD. NO. 22-2014 accepting property by donation at 492 Koerber Avenue for the C.D. Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 23-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for street tree trimming services; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 24-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising, to raise various manholes throughout the City of Akron to grade or above grade to allow proper access for maintenance; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 25-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for lawn restoration services; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 26-2014 urging the U.S. EPA to accept the Mayor's proposal to allow the City of Akron to enter into an Integrated Plan in the same manner as they have given other cities across the country and, in furtherance of this proposal, supporting the continuation of engineering design services of various projects identified in the Long Term Control Plan; supporting the construction of projects mutually agreed upon by U.S. EPA, Ohio EPA, and the City of Akron; amending Chapter 50, Section 50.22 of the Code of Ordinances to increase sewer services charges to EPA mandated levels in order to pay for long term control plan/CSO projects; and devoting any revenues beyond normal operation, maintenance and related costs resulting from this increase to long term control plan/CSO projects related to combined sewer overflows and/or improvements at the Water Pollution Control Station; and establishing an advisory committee to review and make recommendations concerning hiring of local residents and minorities on CSO projects; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 8-5 (Kammer, Mosley-Samples, Omobien, Sommerville & Williams voted no)**

ORD. NO. 27-2014 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with Northeast Ohio Basketball Association for the management, promotion and operation of the King James Shooting Stars Classic basketball event; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 28-2014 expressing sympathy to the families of Stephen Machcinski and James Dickman, two Toledo firefighters, who died heroically while battling an apartment complex fire in North Toledo. **VOTE: 13-0**
