



CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 3, 2014:

ORD. NO. 48-2014 approving the sale of City owned land to Providence Baptist Church; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 49-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with Akron Summit County Public Library for the lease of City-owned land on Shatto Avenue; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 50-2014 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the North Turkeyfoot Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, and providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 51-2014 declaring it necessary to levy assessments for public improvements and public services for the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District in accordance with Ordinance Number 376-2013 which approved the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District and the Plan for Services provided by the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District, Inc. for years 2015-2019, all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 52-2014 declaring that the City of Akron adopts and agrees to participate in the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan developed in conjunction with the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 53-2014 opposing the passage of SB 205 which restricts the mailing of absentee ballot applications and SB 238 which reduces the early voting period; urging the Ohio Democratic Party to challenge the legislation in federal court as a violation of the U.S. Constitution's equal protection clause; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**
