ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 10, 2014:

ORD. NO. 54-2014 approving the donation of City owned land to Westside Neighborhood Development Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 55-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the replacement of the Swinehart Avenue Bridge over the Mud Run Ditch; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 56-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the 2014 Tree Replacement Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 57-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the office of the Purchasing Agent, for the purchase of primary tank collector parts for the Water Reclamation Facility; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 58-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for airport improvements at the Akron-Fulton International Airport; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 59-2014 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Duro-Last Roofing, Inc. for the re-roofing of the Evans Avenue salt dome; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 60-2014 authorizing the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with the Catholic Charities Community Services Corporation for operation of the summer recreation program for youth with disabilities; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 61-2014 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct the Harris Community Learning Center at 1085 Clifton Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 62-2014 amending the Zoning Map by changing the UPD-21 District Classification on property addressed as 690 White Pond Drive (Parcel No. 6900613), and Parcel No. 6900154, to a UPD-44 District Classification; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

ORD. NO. 63-2014 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a senior housing development at 894 Kenmore Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

RES. NO. 64-2014 approving, with modification, the renewal application of Kent J. Shively to have agricultural property at 495 Hickory Street placed in an "agricultural district" pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et. seq.; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

RES. NO. 67-2014 approving, with modification, the renewal application of Elias and Evelia Gudino to have agricultural property at 1080 St. Michaels Avenue placed in an "agricultural district" pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

RES. NO. 68-2014 approving, with modification, the renewal application of 1831 Wooster Avenue LLC to have agricultural property at 1831 Vernon Odom Boulevard placed in an "agricultural district" pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 10-0*

RES. NO. 69-2014 declaring it necessary to improve Kingswood Drive between the termini of Merriman Road and Rocky Hollow Drive, and Rocky Hollow Drive between the termini of Kingswood Drive and Rocky Ridge Drive by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewers and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 10-0***
