



# CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 30, 2014:

**ORD. NO. 196-2014** reaffirming support and authorizing execution of a replacement Guaranty Agreement among the City, the County of Summit and Fifth Third Bank, in connection with the extension of certain credit facilities to Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. (the Akron Urban League”) to refinance bonds issued to pay the costs of the Akron Urban League’s community service center and for its operations; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Mosley-Samples abstained)*

**ORD. NO. 197-2014** authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Finance to negotiate and enter into agreements to secure the East Akron Community House building located at 550 South Arlington Street for purposes of continuing programs, projects, and services for the residents of East Akron; to ensure that the building is used for its originally intended purposes; to make payments in connection with those agreements; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Mosley-Samples abstained)*

**ORD. NO. 198-2014** authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with Great-West Retirement Services to provide additional deferred compensation investment options to City employees; to select additional financial institutions as investment options from time to time; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Mosley-Samples abstained)*

**ORD. NO. 199-2014** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the surface preparation and painting of fire hydrants within the City of Akron; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 200-2014** approving and confirming the appointments by the Mayor of Ken Jones and Rick Merolla as members of the City Planning Commission; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 201-2014** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 202-2014** urging the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company to build its new, state-of-the-art, consumer tire manufacturing plant in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Mosley-Samples did not vote)*
