ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 28, 2014:

ORD. NO. 251-2014 creating, establishing, and recognizing departments, offices, bureaus, divisions and positions in the classified service of the City of Akron; requiring that only budgeted funded positions be filled; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 252-2014 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Bridgestone Americas Tire Operations, LLC, or its affiliate for the acquisition of property located on South Main Street, authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 253-2014 authorizing the execution of an amendment to the Contract for Sale of Land for Private Redevelopment with Testa Enterprises and Concord Testa Hotel Associates to provide for the construction of a hotel and related amenities; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 254-2014 amending and/or supplementing Title 5, "Public Works", Chapter 50, "Sewers", Section 50.22, "Sewer Service Charges" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron, to establish sewer service charges for master meter customers; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 255-2014 approving the Downtown Area Redevelopment Plan; making necessary findings in connection therewith; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 256-2014 expressing support for H.R. 5136, the "Breaking Addiction Act of 2014," introduced by Representatives Marcia Fudge and co-sponsored by Representative Tim Ryan establishing a five-year demonstration project to expand cost-effective, community-based treatment options to address the heroin/opiate epidemic; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
