ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 22, 2014:

ORD. NO. 276-2014 accepting the purchase of a Temporary Right-of-Way document for 931 Evans Avenue described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM-Evans Avenue Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 277-2014 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction Company for the emergency repair of the storm sewer at 1721 Cromwell Drive; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 278-2014 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Canal Construction Company for the emergency repair of the sanitary sewer along Princeton Street south of Kenmore Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 279-2014 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with The Ruhlin Company for the emergency repair of the State Street Bridge; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 280-2014 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Cavanaugh Building Corporation for the emergency repair of the sewer at the intersection of East Market Street and Cook Street; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 281-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the installation of a new electric substation load bank at the Water Reclamation Facility; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 282-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the installation of curb meter pits and appurtenances in the Copley Square allotment; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Swirsky did not vote)*

ORD. NO. 283-2014 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a dog boarding and training facility at 1060 Derby Downs Drive; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 284-2014 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a retail strip plaza on the east side of Home Avenue, north of Independence Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 285-2014 urging the voters of the City of Akron to support the proposed County of Summit sales and use tax increase of one-quarter percent at the November 4, 2014 general election in order to fund essential safety services in the County; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 286-2014 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into a grant agreement with the State of Ohio for funding from the FFY 2015 Ohio Traffic Safety Office, Selective Traffic Enforcement Program; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 287-2014 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into a grant agreement with the State of Ohio for funding from the FFY 2015 Ohio Traffic Safety Office, Impaired Driving Enforcement Program; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
