## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 10, 2014:

**ORD. NO. 342-2014** authorizing the Mayor, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, after accepting informal sealed bills, for the purchase of uniform materials for the Fire Division; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 343-2014** authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City's participation in miscellaneous organizations, associations and agencies; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 344-2014** authorizing the purchase of property at 156 Willard Street for C.D. Land Banking purposes; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 345-2014** authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, and/or the Director of Finance to purchase miscellaneous supplies and repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions and departments of the City for a period of one year; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 346-2014** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M Miller Construction Company for the emergency repair of the sanitary sewer at the intersection of Woodmere Avenue and Millbrook Road; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 347-2014** authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for labor and materials to paint the interior of the Water Reclamation Facility's Administration building and training facility; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 348-2014** authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Itron Inc. for the purchase of automated water meter reading handheld equipment for the Water Distribution Division; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

**ORD. NO. 349-2014** establishing the maximum hiring age for original appointments to Police Officer at thirty-five (35) years of age at the time of examination; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*
